God is drawing people to Himself in many ways and many places. Here are excerpts from a couple missionary letters. Remember that you are part of these ministries through prayer and giving.



Harriet Smith is the prayer coordinator for Bridges International, the Cru ministry to international students. Recently Harriet was co-leader of a team from her

church that went to Nicaragua, and ministered in a variety of settings. Here are some excerpts from her report:

"How can I adequately thank you for participating with

me in the mission trip to Nicaragua through your prayers, encouragement and gifts? God did so much in us and through us that it's really difficult to properly describe the life change that took place among the 14 who participated. But I will do my best to let you in on some of that.

All together we shared the gospel with over 400 people and nearly 50% indicated faith. We saw



extreme poverty, but we also witnessed the love and determination of people to overcome the odds.

From Mark Lewis, Director of ReachGlobal, crisis response ministry of EFCA.

...Emily (daughter) and I will be heading to The Philippines, and the area that was devastated by Typhoon Haiyan in 2013. Since then, the Lord has brought about significant growth in the church. Over a dozen new churches have been planted in the region since the storm, and the original church planters are now leading multiple churches and teams of church planters, so last year, we started meeting with them to help in their development and equipping as their roles have changed.

We'll also spend a few days investigating the possibility of starting a Global Fingerprints child sponsorship program in the region. Emily will be filming interviews with the church planters and their teams, to document the incredible fruits that have resulted from ministry in this region since the Typhoon.

PRAY: that the Lord would use us to encourage our Brothers, and that the Holy Spirit would continue to move through these Godly leaders.

EVANGELISM MINISTRY



"To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God" (Acts 26:18). This commissioning of the Apostle Paul by the Lord Jesus is very relevant for today. In witnessing for the Lord, it is not uncommon to meet those who are involved in idolatry through adherence to a cult. In these encounters, the Holy Spirit is well able to bring light and life to a darkened heart through the message of the gospel.

Recently, at a local hospital, a Forcey member met a middle-aged patient named Gloria. As they discussed her spiritual background, he discovered that she had been exposed to a cult that was attempting to indoctrinate her in its idolatrous paths. Despite her cultic involvement, Gloria allowed the Forcey member to present to her the gospel of Christ. She listened

respectfully but was somewhat combative on certain doctrinal issues. However, the Forcey member persisted in presenting God's plan of salvation through faith in the Lord Jesus, trusting the Holy Spirit to open her eyes to the truth of the gospel.

When the Forcey member asked Gloria if she wanted to receive the Lord Jesus as her Savior, to his surprise and delight she responded "Yes." Gloria then called upon the Lord Jesus to

forgive her sins and to save her soul. After reviewing with her the assurance of her salvation in Christ, the Forcey member left with a

thankful heart that this patient had indeed turned "from darkness to light" by the power of the Spirit of God.
