Forgiveness based on:	Ongoing <u>sacrifices</u>	Jesus' <u>perfect</u> sacrifice
Blessing dependent on:	National integrity and priestly purity	Obedience from the heart.
Current Effect:	<u>Obsolete</u>	<u>Permanent</u>

### Discussion Guide & Questions from Hebrews 8:1-9:10

- 1. In what ways does Jesus have a superior priestly ministry than the Levitical priesthood established in the Old Covenant?
- 2. Based on verses 7-8, why did the Old Covenant need to be replaced for the people?
- 3. In verses 8-12, the writer of Hebrews quotes Jeremiah 31:31-34. What are you most thankful for about the New Covenant? Discuss.
- 4. The book of Hebrews was written to Jewish believers who faced the temptation to return to Old Covenant observances. How do you explain the "pull" backward to a former religious observance or philosophy of life? In what ways is this a temptation "common to man" (1 Corinthians 10:13). In what ways might you feel a "pull" to turn back to your own former ways of religion or philosophy of life?
- 5. The first step in embracing a new truth is admitting your lack without it. What was the lack which the Old Covenant eventually revealed, and how does Jesus fill that lack?
- 6. Unlike the Jewish people who observed the Old Covenant, God has given all believers the Holy Spirit (John 14:17). How should the reality of the presence of the Holy Spirit change how we think about our sins or failures?
- 7. From verse 13: In the Old Covenant, the motivation for religious and social life surrounded the priestly system of observances and sacrifices. What is the proper motivation for a believer in the New Covenant whose living is no longer motivated by a now "obsolete" system?
